1 Four families, each with three members:

3 One turkey for each family:

$$\square \times \square = \square \text{ Turkeys}$$



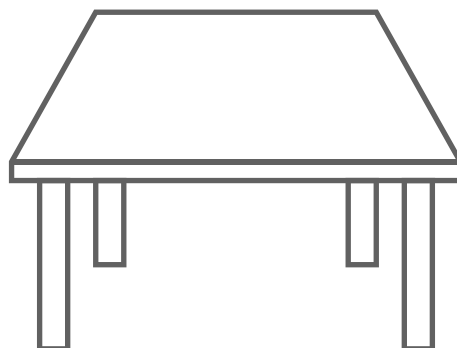
4 Two pumpkin decorations for each person

$$\square \times \square = \square \text{ Pumpkins}$$



5 Two side dishes per family

$$\square \times \square = \square \text{ Side dishes}$$



Answer Key



1 Four families, each with three members:

$$\boxed{4} \times \boxed{3} = \boxed{12} \text{ People}$$



2 Two pies, each with six slices:

$$\boxed{2} \times \boxed{6} = \boxed{12} \text{ Slices of pie}$$



3 One turkey for each family:

$$\boxed{1} \times \boxed{4} = \boxed{4} \text{ Turkeys}$$



4 Two pumpkin decorations for each person

$$\boxed{2} \times \boxed{12} = \boxed{24} \text{ Pumpkins}$$



5 Two side dishes per family

$$\boxed{2} \times \boxed{4} = \boxed{8} \text{ Side dishes}$$
