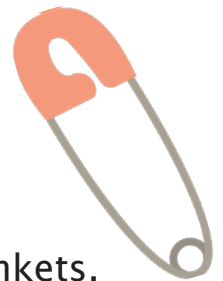




# Baby Clothing True or False
