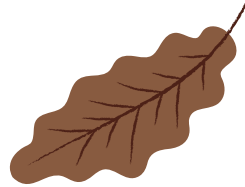


Fall Garden Cleanup



FALL GARDEN CLEANUP FOR THE VEGETABLE AND HERB GARDEN

- Remove Spent or Dead Plants
- Clean Up and Compost Fallen Fruit
- Finish Harvesting and Drying Herbs
- Weed Thoroughly
- Apply Compost and Mulch
- Compost Old Plants; Dispose of Diseased Ones
- Make New Beds



FALL CLEANUP FOR ORNAMENTAL AND FLOWER GARDENS

- Remove diseased foliage and spent plants
- Plant shrubs, trees, and perennials
- Plant spring and summer blooming bulbs
- Give newly-planted plants plenty of mulch
- Remove annuals from containers
- Weed and mulch
- Make any new beds so they're ready to plant in the spring

FALL CLEANUP FOR THE LAWN

- Rake leaves or use a mulching mower
- Seed thin or bare spots in the lawn
- Give the lawn a final mowing
- Fertilize or topdress with compost
