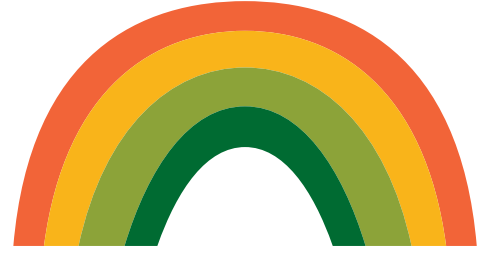

1. The Emerald Isle
2. Green
3. This is a nod to the Emerald Isle and to the iconic Irish shamrock. It also supposedly makes you invisible to those pinching leprechauns!
4. Blue
5. Orange
6. It is the day that Saint Patrick died.
7. Four days
8. They go to church! Many people don't realize that this is a religious holiday.
9. Snakes
10. A mischievous male fairy
11. They are cobblers (shoemakers)
12. This will depend on the leprechaun's age. Irish folklore notes that there is one gold coin for every year of a leprechaun's life.
13. This is a naturally occurring ring of mushrooms. The Irish believe that they are a marker for underground fairy villages.
14. Fairy rings are a sign of good luck, unless you destroy these magical markers.
15. Shamrocks are the official symbol of Ireland and a sign of good luck. In contrast, a four-leaf clover has an extra leaf, making it an extra lucky find!
